The following Departmental Examinations for (**Session October/November, 2022**) will be held during the month of **December, 2022** at Head Office Sindh Public Service Commission, Thandi Sarak, Hyderabad .

- 01) Assistant Collectors Part-I & II
- 02) Revenue Qualifying Examination (R.Q.E)
- 03) Forest Officer
- 04) Sub-Ordinate Accounts Service (S.A.S) Part- I & II
- 05) Superintendent Jail BPS-18
- 06) Deputy Superintendent Jail BPS-17
- 07) Assistant Superintendent Jail BPS-16
- 08) Administrative Officer Jail Department BPS-16
- 09) Sub-Ordinate Treasury Accounts Service (Accountant & Accounts Clerk)

2. The Examinations will be subject to syllabus and the rules applicable read with the Sindh Civil Servants (Departmental Examinations) Rules 1978 and Standing Orders of Board of Revenue, Sindh.

3. The candidates may send their particulars on the prescribed proforma through their **Appointing Authority**, along with a challan of Rs: 500 (Rupees five hundred only) duly paid under the Head of Account "**C02101 – Organ of state Examination Fees (Sindh Public Service Commission) Receipt**" (in original). The Prescribed Proforma, duly countersigned by the Competent Authority, may reach Sindh Public Service Commission Head Office not later than **13-10-2022**. The candidates whose particulars are not received from the concerned Administrative Department on or before closing date or they failed to enclose required Challan of Examination fees duly paid in the correct Head of Accounts, **shall not be admitted to the Examination.**

4. If the Departmental Examinations contains two parts, separate Examination Fees of **Rs: 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only)** is to be paid for each part of the said Departmental Examination. The prior special permission for appearing in both parts of Examinations, simultaneously, is essential for admission in the second part.

5. The number of attempts made by the candidate previously with result thereof should clearly be indicated **elsewhere their application will not be entertained.**

6. The candidates, who could not secure 35% or more marks in previous attempt of Revenue Qualifying Examination **will not be considered as eligible candidates** as per Standing Orders of Board of Revenue, Sindh at Note 08-A at Page No. 290, and as per Orders of Honourable Sindh High Court Circuit Bench, Hyderabad dated:06.01.2021 C.P No. D-1481 of 2020 filled by Ms. Sajjad Ahmed S/O Masood Ahmed Bughio v/s Province of Sindh, "eligibility of officials of Board of Revenue Sindh for Revenue Qualifying Examination the eligibility criteria fixed in Standing Order No. 11 Section-E of Revenue Department Sindh Shall be Strictly followed and no deviation for so ever shall occur in all future times". Expecting Special Permission issued by the Competent Authority/Appointing Authority to the candidates of other Departments.

7. If a candidate, admitted in the Examination is unable to appear for any reason, he should send such intimation to the Additional Controller of Examinations, Sindh Public Service Commission, Hyderabad at least **07 days** before the date of commencement of Examinations.

8. **NO APPLICATION SHALL BE ENTERTAINED IF RECEIVED AFTER THE EXPIRY OF CLOSING DATE i.e. 13-10-2022.**
