PRESS RELEASE

The Sindh Public Service Commission (SPSC) has received several representations regarding the rejection of the candidates over qualification of Lecturer (BPS-17) Biology claiming that the degree in Master's in Biology is not being awarded by any Institution or University rather Master's in Zoology or Botany is being awarded. The learned Member (Appeals) has also advised to take up the matter with the Administrative Department.

The SPSC has taken into consideration grievances of the rejected candidates and decided to appraise the matter of qualification of Lecturer Biology (BPS-17) in Provincial Institute of Teacher Education (PITE) under SELD with the Administrative Department.

Therefore, in view of the advice of the learned Member (Appeals), SPSC and giving sympathetic consideration to the appeals of rejected candidates it has been decided that the recruitment process for the post of Lecturer Biology (BPS-17) in PITE under School Education & Literacy Department (advertised through consolidated advertisement No. 03/2024 dated 10.06.2024) may be halted till a viable solution is communicated by the SELD. Also, the interviews for the post of Instructor/Lecturer (BPS-17) Biology in School Education & Literacy Department (being similar in case), advertised through consolidated advertisement No. 05/2023 dated 10.04.2023, scheduled to be held w.e.f. 02.09.2025 are also postponed for similar reasons.
